In February 2023, a new **Project Team** was put in place by the City of Wolverhampton Council (CWC) to help manage the next stage of the **New Park Village Estate re-development**.



Sangita Kular has been appointed as Service Manager for Regeneration. Sangita has been working for CWC since 2000 and was previously Project Manager for the Heath Town Estate Re-development.



Chris Elgerton, Housing Development Project Manager, has also been appointed to progress the project onto the next stage and through to completion. Chris has worked for CWC since 2006 and has been with the Housing Development Team for 10 years, delivering new council homes across the City.

Both Sangita and Chris are delighted to be involved with such an exciting project and look forward to working alongside the New Park Village Tenant Management Co-Operative (NPV TMC), its Committee Members, the Resident Steering Group (NPV RSG), the Tenant Participation Advisory Service (TPAS) and, of course, NPV residents to ensure that this vibrant community has a bright future.

Sangita and Chris will soon be joined by a dedicated Housing Estate Renewal Officer and a Housing Support Apprentice who will both be working on this project to provide further support to progress the redevelopment plans. We will introduce them in the next resident update.

In order to ensure that the new homes in the re-development meet the needs and requirements of residents, a further Housing Needs survey will need to be completed by residents living within the re-development area.
